Local fire departments responded to the fire at the Cedar River Golf Course Maintenance Building early this morning, where the building was determined to be a total loss, housing over a million dollars of golf course equipment. State and local fire inspectors will be on site today to determine the cause of the fire.

The fire will not have an effect on daily operations at Shanty Creek. "With the exception of this particular building, all other areas of the resort are open and operating, including our three lodging facilities, ski operations and food and beverage outlets", states acting COO, Brent Nelson.
